From Pak Sha Wan, in a North-Easterly to Northly direction, between the hours of 6.30 p.m. and Midnight.

On Tuesday and Thursday, the 13th and 15th January :—

From Mount Davis, in a North-Westerly to South-Westerly direction, between the hours of 10 a.m. and 1 p.m.

All ships, junks and other vessels are to keep clear of the ranges.
