PROPOSED TERMS OF THE SALE AND CROWN LEASE.

1. In consideration of the terms agreed upon and upon completion of the reclamation of the Lot to the satisfaction of the Director of Public Works, it is proposed to grant a Crown Lease of the whole of the area coloured red on the said plan and having an area of about 17,000 square feet for the term of 75 years (renewable on the usual terms) commencing from the date when the said area, coloured red, is placed at the disposal of the lessees.
