NOTICE is hereby given that Kodonoshima Buoy, Mihara-seto, Inland Sea, which drifted the other day (see notification No. 11 instant) has been removed in its due position.

Hokkaido.

NOTICE is hereby given that the report has been forwarded by the Government of Hokkaido, relating the following lighted buoys, Mororan Harbour, Province of Iburi, Hokkaido, which have been moored on the 1st February, 1921, to show the ends of the rubble mounds of Mororan-ko Breakwaters which are now under construction:—

Mororan-ko No. 1 Temporary Lighted Buoy.

Position:—The end of projected line of the North breakwater.

Description:—Iron frustum of cone, painted black, surmounted by a lattice work supporting a lantern.

Height of Light:—About 12 “shaku” above the water.

Character:—Flashing white light, showing 1 flash in every 6½ seconds.

Illuminated Arc:—The whole horizon.

Power:—100 candles.

Visibility:—8½ nautical miles in clear night.

Depth of Water:—About 8 fathoms at L. W. S. T.

Position:—The end of projected line of the South breakwater.

Description:—Wooden frustum of pyramid, painted red, surmounted by a spherical top mark suspending a fixed red light lamp each on both sides.

Height of Light:—About 7½ “shaku” above the water.

Illuminated Arc:—The whole horizon.

Visibility:—2 nautical miles in clear night.

Depth of Water:—About 9 fathoms at L. W. S. T.
