New Light Established—Gihulñgan.

A fixed red light, large lens lantern, has been established at the beach of Gihulñgan, eastern part of Negros. The light is displayed from a white concrete beacon, 30 ft. above ground and 36 ft. above mean high water. Distance of visibility, 7 miles.

Approximate position :—

Latitude 10° 07' 18" N.
Longitude 123° 16' 18" E.

Coron Passage—Buoy Temporarily Replaced.

The third class red nun buoy which marks the end of the reef making out from the south end of Uson Island, Coron Passage, which was reported as missing in Notice to Mariners No. 592, dated July 12, 1920, has been temporarily replaced by a second class red nun buoy.

Shimonoseki Strait.

NOTICE is hereby given that, following Tidal Observation Lighted-Buoy will be moored about Dannoura coast, Hayatomo-Seto, Shimo-no-seki Strait, in near future, and Gomiysesu lighted buoy, W. entrance to the strait, be with-drawn.

Further notice will be given after the buoys have been effected.

Hayatomoseto Tidal Observation Lighted Buoy.

Description :.....—Iron frustum of cone, one half side painted white and the other half side red, and surmounted by a lattice-work supporting a lantern.

Height of light :—10 “shaku” above the water.

Character :—Pintch gas, fixed light showing, the one half side white and the other half side red, in accordance with the painting colours.

Illuminated arc :—The whole horizon.

Power :—White light 130, red light 50 candles.

Visible distance :—8 nautical miles each, in clear night:

Remarks :—Being liable to stand for tidal currency, the red or white side of the buoy always changeable to the observer. In case of easterly current, it shows white side to-wards Hinoyamashita warning signal station, and of westerly current, red side.
