*Uncharted Rock Discovered between Shingan Island and Slut Island,
Northern Entrance to Haitan Strait.*

NOTICE is hereby given that an uncharted rock has been discovered in the passage between Shingan Island and Slut Island at the northern entrance to Haitan Strait. From the rock, Slut Island summit bears No. 88° W., magnetic, distant 7.2 cables (British Admiralty Chart No. 1985).

The rock has 14 feet of water on it at low water of spring tides.
