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CHINA STATION HYDROGRAPHICAL MEMORANDA.

**62. Strait of Malacca—Approaches to Perak River.**

*Sembilan Island—White Rock.*

A white flashing light was exhibited from white Rock as from 15th May, 1925.

*Character.*—Flash, 2 seconds; eclipse, 7 seconds. No further details given.

**63. China Coast.—Gulf of Siam—Cone Islet.**

*Establishment of Light.*

A fixed white light, sixty-eight feet above sea level, visible ten miles, has been established on the west point of Cone Islet.

*Position (approximate).*—Latitude  $11^{\circ} 25' N.$ , longitude  $103^{\circ} 00' E.$

*Remarks.*—Light structure is painted red.

*Charts affected.*—2722, 2414.

*Authority.*—Saigon Notice to Mariners.

**64. Japan.—Shimonoseki Strait—Eastern Approaches.**

*Buoys for Surveying Purposes.*

Four buoys for surveying purposes (two lit and two unlit) have been placed inside an area with one-mile radius from a position  $128^{\circ} 2\frac{1}{4}$  miles from He Saki lighthouse.

These buoys will be moved to the south-eastward for a distance of about five miles as work progresses.

Ships can navigate freely round them.
