Lamocks Islands.

*Main Light Lantern Damaged—Temporary Lights Established.*

Referring to Notice to Mariners No. 828, notice is hereby given that temporary lights have been established at Lamocks Islands.

The temporary lights each show a *white* light, flashing every 12 seconds, thus:—

Light ... .. 1½ seconds,  
Eclipse... .. 10½ seconds,

and are so arranged that one or the other of them will be visible all round the horizon in clear weather for a distance of about 10 nautical miles.
