### A BILL

#### INTITULED

An Ordinance to apply a sum not exceeding Eighteen million seven hundred and sixty-seven thousand seven hundred and seventy-seven Dollars to the Public Service of the year 1926.

Whereas the expenditure required for the service of this Colony for the year 1926 has, apart from the contribution to the Imperial Government in aid of Military Expenditure and Charges on account of Public Debt, been estimated at the sum of Eighteen million seven hundred and sixty-seven thousand seven hundred and seventy-seven Dollars:

BE it enacted by the Governor of Hongkong, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:—

Short title.

- 1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Appropriation Ordinance for 1926.
- 2. A sum not exceeding Eighteen million seven hundred and sixty-seven thousand seven hundred and seventy-seven Dollars shall be and the same is hereby charged upon the revenue and other funds of the Colony for the service of the year 1926, and the said sum so charged may be expended as hereinafter specified, that is to say:—
