Registration of these 4 marks shall give no right to the exclusive use of the word "CEYLON" and that these 4 marks are associated with one another and with the "CEYLONTA" (word) mark of pending application No. 566 of 1937.

Registration of the "Blue label" and the "Green label" marks shall give no right to the exclusive use of the word "LIPTON'S".
