EXAMINATIONS FOR THE CIVIL SERVICE OF INDIA. REGULATIONS.

1. In July 1859, an Examination of candidates will be held in London. Forty candidates will be selected, if so many shall be found the partial. Of these twenty-five will be selected for the Presidency of Bengal, eight for that of Madras, and seven for that of Bombay.

Any natural-born subject of Her Majesty, who shall be desirous of entering the Civil Service of India, will be entitled to be act at such Examination, provided he shall, on or before the 1st May 1859, have transmitted to the Civil Service Commissioners,
