On and after the 1st of June, 1863, a FLOATING LIGHT-SHIP will be moored inside the Little Basses Reef:—The entre of Rocks bearing S.bW. 1 W., distant about one-third of a mile.

It will exhibit a Flashing Light between the hours of sunset and sunrise, at intervals of one minute and a half.

It is 33 feet above the Sea, and from the horizon dips at 7 miles; to a ship within that distance, in fine weather, it does not entirely disappear; and is visible 11 miles from a ship's deck of 18 feet elevation.
