Kellet's Island bearing E. by S. $\frac{1}{2}$ S.

All ships to be *properly moored* with 35 fathoms chain (East and West.)

The passage between North Boundary of Man-of-war anchorage and the Kowloon Peninsula to be kept clear.

The Vessels of the P. & O. Steam Navigation Company, when *not* at the Company's buoy, to moor in a North Westerly direction from the *Fort William*.

The Vessels of the "Messageries Imperiales" to moor in a North Westerly direction from the *Melville*.

Steamers and Vessels not having any definite employment will still remain on the North side near H. M. S. *Hercules*.
