

NOTICE.

All persons intending to apply for Seamen's Boarding House Licenses for the Year 1864-65 under Ordinance No. 6 of 1852, are to send in their applications in writing to this Office on or before Monday the 21st instant, stating accurately the position of the House, and that there is an entire dwelling intervening between it and any House licensed for the sale of spirituous or fermented liquors.

In measuring the rooms, strict regard will be paid to the Regulations laid down on January 1st 1855, and no License will be granted to any House that does not come within the full meaning of the Ordinance.

Before a License can be issued the applicant will be required to produce the sanction of the First Police Magistrate.
