The Red Ensign, and Union Jack with a white border, are to continue (as prescribed by art. 1) the National Colours for all other British ships, with the exception of yachts and such other vessels as their Lordships may from time to time authorise to bear distinguishing flags.

All regulations not conflicting with the foregoing, remain in force.
