IN THE SUPREME COURT OF HONGKONG IN BANKRUPTCY.

NOTICE.—JOSEPH HENRY BAKER, of 24, Queen's Road Central, Victoria, in the Colony of Hongkong, Draper, &c., having been adjudged Bankrupt under a Petition for adjudication of Bankruptcy, filed in the Supreme Court on the *Twenty-sixth day of August, in the Year of our Lord One thousand Eight hundred and Seventy-four*, is hereby required to surrender himself to William Hastings Alexander, Esquire, the Registrar of the said Court, at the first Meeting of his Creditors, to be held on the *Eighth day of September, in the Year of Our Lord One thousand Eight hundred and Seventy-four*, at Eleven of the clock in the forenoon of that day precisely, at the said Court.
