IN THE SUPREME COURT OF HONGKONG IN BANKRUPTCY.

NOTICE.—JOHN WILLIAM FINCH of Victoria, in the Island of Hongkong, Master Mariner, having been adjudged Bankrupt under a Petition for adjudication of Bankruptcy, filed in the Supreme Court of Hongkong on the Seventh day of November, in the Year of our Lord 1874, is hereby required to surrender himself to the Honorable William Hastings Alexander, the Registrar of the said Court, at the first meeting of Creditors, to be held before the said Registrar on the Eighteenth day of November, 1874, at Eleven o'clock in the forenoon of that day precisely, at the said Court.

The said Honorable William Hastings Alexander is the Official Assignee, and Messrs. Caldwell & Brereton, of Victoria aforesaid, are the Solicitors acting in the Bankruptcy.

A public sitting will hereafter be appointed by the said Court for the said Bankrupt to pass his

final examination and to make application for his discharge, of which sitting notice will be given in the Hongkong Government Gazette.

At the first meeting of Creditors the Registrar will receive the proofs of the debts of Creditors and the Creditors may elect an Assignee or Assignees of the Bankrupt's Estate and Effects.
