METEOROLOGICAL OBSERVATIONS

TAKEN AT THE GOVERNMENT CIVIL HOSPITAL, VICTORIA, HONGKONG, FOR THE MONTH OF NOVEMBER, 1874. 86 feet above mean low level of Spring Tides.

Main table with columns: DAY OF MONTH, DAY OF WEEK, ANEROID BAROMETER, THERMOMETERS (Fahrenheit), WIND, HYGROMETER, DRY BULB IN WET BULBIN SHADE, HUMIDITY COMPLETE SATURATION = 100, DEW POINT, QUARTER, RAIN IN INCHES DURING THE PREVIOUS 24 HOURS, CLOUD, OZONE.

Summary of November, 1873: Mean Shade Temp., Total Rain fall, 0.88 inches. Rain fell on 2 days.
