Sir,—The undersigned Committee have the honour to state that, in accordance with the established regulations, a public meeting of the members of the Kái-fong of the whole of Hongkong was summoned on the 19th day of the 5th moon (20th ultimo) for the public election of new Directors, who should take over the management of all the affairs, great and small, connected with the Tung-wá Hospital.
