## ORDINANCE No. 9 OF 1883.

An Ordinance enacted by the Governor of Hongkong, with the advice of the Legislative Council thereof, entitled *The Merchant Shipping Consolidation Ordinance, 1879, Amendment Ordinance, 1883.*

[20th July, 1883.]

Enacted by the Governor of Hongkong, with the advice of the Legislative Council thereof,

Section 25 of Ordinance 8 of 1879 is hereby amended by striking out the words of Section 25 and substituting therein thereof the words:—

"The Governor in Council may from time to time make, and when made, revoke, add to, or alter the Regulations as the Governor in Council may deem necessary for maintaining and enforcing an effective quarantine in the ports and waters of the Colony, and for the setting apart of suitable and convenient situations for Quarantine Stations, and providing for the detention and seclusion of persons arriving on board vessels subjected to quarantine."

Any person offending against any such regulations shall be liable on summary conviction before a Magistrate to a penalty not exceeding \$2,000 or to imprisonment with or without hard labour for a term not exceeding 12 months, or at the discretion of the Police Magistrate to both imprisonment, and the Captain Superintendent of Police and any officers that he may employ for the purpose of enforcing quarantine, shall have the same powers to prevent the commission of such regulations, and to arrest, recapture, or detain offenders against them as may be granted by any person for the prevention of any felony, or the arrest, recapture, or detention of a

Penalty for breach of Quarantine Regulations; and powers of Police to arrest, &c.

Repeal.

Section 16 of 1882 is hereby repealed, provided that such repeal shall not affect the past operations of the said Ordinance, or anything done or suffered thereunder, or any liability or punishment incurred thereunder.
