#### CONDITIONS.

- The holder shall preserve his licence and produce it when called upon to do so by a Magistrate, Justice of the Peace or Police Officer.
- 2. He shall abstain from any violation of the law.
- 3. He shall not habitually associate with notoriously bad characters, such as reputed thieves and prostitutes.
- 4. He shall not lead an idle and dissolute life without visible means of obtaining an honest livelihood.
- If his licence is forfeited or revoked in consequence of a conviction for any offence, he will be liable to undergo a term of imprisonment with hard labour equal to the portion of his term of years which remained unexpired when his licence was granted, viz., the term of years.
