ASSESSMENT NOTICE.

Assessments for *The Hill District, Pokfulam, Sokonpo* and *Kowloon Point* for 1888-9 will be published for inspection at the Treasury for twenty-one days commencing from Friday, 1st June.

These assessments will be in force from July 1st, 1888, to June 30th, 1889.

Appeals to the Supreme Court will be received until June 21st. Notice stating the grounds of appeal must also be sent to the Assessor on or before that date.

The same procedure for all other Villages and Country Districts has been adopted as that for the above for the year 1889.

If the value of any Tenement has been altered from that now in force, the Assessor has the right to call on the Owner, if his address is known, or if not, to the occupier with a view to the same to the Owner. The omission to serve such notice does not invalidate an appeal against any assessment within the prescribed time, 1888. All Owners or Occupiers interested in rateable property in the above Villages and Country Districts are therefore inspected the Rate Book within this period.
