REGULATION

Made by the Governor in Council under Section 3 of The Vaccination Ordinance, 1888, (No. 1 of 1888), this 3rd day of July, 1888.

The following shall be the places for the purposes of public vaccination at the times specified opposite each place, viz.:—

- The Government Civil Hospital,Daily, (Saturdays and Sundays excepted) from 2 to 4 P.M.
- The Tung Wa Hospital,.....On the 5th, 11th, 17th, 23rd, and 29th of each Chinese month.
- The Alice Memorial Hospital,Daily, (Saturdays and Sundays excepted) from 2 to 4 P.M.
- Village of Yaumati,On the 6th of each Chinese month.
- „ „ Shaukiwán,On the 12th of each Chinese month.
- „ „ Aberdeen,.....On the 18th of each Chinese month.
