AVIS AUX NAVIGATEURS.

L'Administration a l'honneur de prévenir MM. les navigateurs qu'on a constaté l'existence, dans la passe de la rivière de Saïgon, entre le cap Saint-Jacques et le banc de Cangio, d'un haut fond dont les relèvements sont les suivants :

- Phare du cap Saint-Jacques, N. 65° Est ;
- Pointe Nord de la baie des Cocotiers, N. 15° Ouest ;
- Pointe Sud de la baie des Cocotiers, N. 5° Est ;
- Feu rouge de Cangio, N. 34° Ouest ;
- Pointe extrême Sud du cap Saint-Jacques, N. 89° Est.

Ce haut fond, sur lequel il ne reste que 6 mètr 2 cent. aux basses mers, est placé dans le chenal du cap Saint-Jacques à 1,080 mètres du rivage sur la route suivie par les navires et au milieu de fonds variant de 10 à 12 mètres.

Il est indiqué provisoirement par une petite bouée noire placée sur son sommet.
