## GOVERNMENT NOTIFICATION.—No. 439.

An Ordinance to continue the Hongkong and Shanghai Bank Ordinance, 1899.

Whereas it is expedient that the power of issuing bills and notes in excess of its paid-up capital which was conferred for the period of one year from the 31st day of July, 1898, upon the Hongkong and Shanghai Banking Corporation, under certain conditions, by section 3 of Ordinance 1 of 1899, should be continued, under the same conditions, for the period of one year from the 31st day of July, 1899.

Be it enacted by the Governor of Hongkong, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:—

- 1. This Bill may be cited as the Hongkong and Shanghai Short title. Bank Excess of Note Issue Ordinance, 1899.
- 2. All the provisions of section 3 of Ordinance 1 of 1899 are hereby continued for the period of one year from the 31st day of July, 1899.
