

Expenses shall be made good by the defaulter and be recoverable as liquidated damages, or at the option and pleasure of His Majesty to re-enter and resume the property as if no sale had ever taken place, in which case also the premium paid by the Purchaser shall be thereupon wholly forfeited to His Majesty.
