FOWLER BAY.

Shipmasters and others are hereby informed that a Warping Buoy, painted black, has been placed in a position about 100 fathoms to seaward of and in a direct line with the Fowler Bay Jetty. As the anchor has only about 7ft. 6in. of water over it at L.W.S., a small Cask Buoy has been placed to mark its exact position, which vessels should be careful to avoid. The mooring in question is for warping only, and must not on any account be used for any other purpose.
