

GOVERNMENT NOTIFICATION.—No. 579.

Notice is hereby given, under the provisions of section 15 of The New Territories Land Court Ordinance, 1900, that His Excellency the Governor has fixed the ninth day of January, 1902, as the date after which all persons in occupation of land in the district hereunder specified, to wit, No. 8 Survey District, the boundaries of which are hereunder specified, shall be deemed trespassers as against the Crown, unless such occupation is authorized by grant from the Crown or by other title allowed by the Court under the said Ordinance or by licence from the Governor or from some Government Officer having authority to grant such licence, or unless a claim to be entitled to such occupation has been duly presented to the Court and has not been withdrawn or heard and disallowed.

Boundaries of No. 8 Survey District.

On the North:—

The Northern Boundary of the New Territory, from the top of the Lin Ma Hang Gap to the Lo Fu Ferry.

On the West:—

The river flowing into the Sam Chun River at the Lo Fu Ferry, from the ferry along the branch flowing east of Sheung Shui to the notice boards that mark the boundary of the Tái Pó Survey District near Kau Lung Hang.

On the South:—

The Boundary of the Tái Pó Survey District, from the boundary marks at Kau Lung Hang to the western peak of the Pat Sin Ling.

On the East:—

The Boundary of the Sha T'au Kok Survey District, from the western peak of the Pat Sin Ling to the Lin Ma Hang Gap.
