ORDER

Made by the Governor in Council under the provisions of "The Commissioners Powers Ordinance, 1886," on the 23rd day of October, 1901.

Under and by virtue of the provisions of Section 2 of "The Commissioners Powers Ordinance 1886" in that behalf I, Sir Henry Arthur Blake, G.C.M.G., Governor and Commander-in-Chief of the Colony of Hongkong and its Dependencies and Vice-Admiral of the same, in Executive Council, do hereby nominate and appoint Godfrey Cornewall Chester Master, Esquire, to be a Member of the Commission appointed by myself in Executive Council under the Seal of the Colony on the 11th day of October, 1901, in the place of the Honourable Henry Edward Pollock, K.C., resigned.
