ORDER

Made by the Officer Administering the Government in Council, under section 39 sub-section (1.) of The Rating Ordinance, 1901, this 3rd day of May, 1902.

Whereas by section 39 sub-section (1.) of The Rating Ordinance, 1901, it is provided as follows:—

"Tenements below the rateable value of such minimum amount as may be fixed by the Governor in Council from time to time and notified in the Gazette shall not be rateable":

Now I, Major-General Sir William Julius Gascoigne, K.C.M.G., the Officer for the time being Administering the Government of Hongkong in Council, do hereby fix the rateable value of \$20 per annum as the minimum amount below which tenements shall not be rateable from the 1st day of July next.
