It is hereby notified that His Majesty the King has not been advised to exercise his power of disallowance with respect to the following Ordinances:—

Ordinance No. 15 of 1902, entitled—An Ordinance to amend The Marriage Ordinance, (14 of 1875).

Ordinance No. 16 of 1902, entitled—An Ordinance to release certain premises situate at Victoria in the Colony of Hongkong from a Settlement dated the 31st day of March 1884 and made between Meyer Elias Sassoon of the one part and Frederick David Sassoon, Edward Elias Sassoon and the said Meyer Elias Sassoon of the other part.
