REGULATION

*Made by the Governor in Council on the 14th day of October, 1902, under the authority of section 4 of The Naval Stores Ordinance, (No. 9 of 1875).*

Repeal.

1. Section 1 of the Regulations made by the Administrator in Council on the 14th day of October, 1875, is hereby repealed.

Licence fee for dealer in marine stores or old metal.

2. From and after the date when this Regulation comes into operation the fee for each licence to use or exercise the trade or business of a dealer in marine stores, or a dealer in old metals, shall be \$30 per mensem payable in advance.

Commencement of Regulation.

3. This Regulation shall come into operation on the publication thereof in the *Government Gazette*.

*Made by the Governor in Council on the 14th day of October, 1902, under section 3 of The Licensing Consolidation Ordinance, (No. 21 of 1887).*

1. The fees set forth in the schedule hereto shall be charged for the issue of the licences described in such schedule in substitution for the fees authorized by the schedule to the Licensing Consolidation Ordinance, 1887.

Chinese Money Changer, .....	\$ 10
Chinese Undertaker, .....	\$ 20
