ORDER

Made by His Excellency the Governor in Council, under The Stamp Ordinance, 1901, this 16th day of December, 1902.

Whereas by The Stamp Ordinance, 1901, the Governor in Council may make Rules prescribing the manner of cancelling stamps and also for authorizing the use of adhesive stamps for any documents required to bear stamps, and whereas by an Order of the Governor in Council made on the 23rd day of October, 1901, it was prescribed that adhesive stamps might be used for certain classes of documents, it is hereby ordered as follows:—

No adhesive stamp used under the provisions of the above mentioned Order in Council shall be deemed to be properly cancelled unless the true date of cancellation be legibly and indelibly marked either wholly on the stamp or partly on the stamp and partly on the document to which the stamp is affixed.
