SUPREME COURT.

"The Companies (Local Registers) Ordinance, 1907." (No. 16 of 1907.)

Companies whose objects comprise the transaction of business outside the Colony that are desirous of keeping Registers in any place out of the Colony in which such Companies transact business are reminded that they can only do so by an Annual Licence issued by the Governor-in-Council as required by Section 4 of the above recited Ordinance, upon proof to the satisfaction of the Governor-in-Council that a principal part of the business of the Company is carried on at or near the place where it desires to keep such Register.
