BE it enacted by the Governor of Hongkong, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:-

1. This Ordinance may be cited as "The Widows' and Short title Orphaus' Pension Amendment (No. 2) Ordinance, 1911", and consand shall be read as one with the Widows' and Orphaus' Pension Ordinance, 1908, hereinafter called "the Principal Ordinance", as amended by the Widows' and Orphaus' Pension (Amendment) Ordinance, 1909, and by the Widows' and Orphans' Pension Amendment Ordinance, 1911.

2. Section 18 of the Principal Ordinance is amended by Amendment inserting after the words "on attaining the age of 65" the words "or on leaving the service".
