COLONIAL SECRETARY'S DEPARTMENT.

No. 409.—The attention of the public is drawn to section 4 of the Alien Enemies (Winding up) Ordinance, 1914, which provides that no German or Austro-Hungarian may make any disposition of any property without the permission of His Excellency the Governor. Accordingly, all persons proposing to have any dealings with alien enemies with respect to their property should satisfy themselves that permission has been obtained for the transaction contemplated, as anyone entering into such a transaction for which no permission has been obtained will not only find that the transaction is void but will also render himself liable to fine and imprisonment.
