ALTERATIONS OF CHIEF IMPORTANCE.

Changes of greater or less importance occur in many of the formulæ of the British Pharmacopæia, 1914, as compared with the issue of 1898, but attention is particularly directed to the more notable alterations in potency, which are indicated in percentages (p.c.) in the following table:—
