No. 202.—It is hereby notified that after May 1st, passengers will not be permitted to land at Marseilles unless provided with a passport bearing the visa of a French consular officer. Passports will be examined by the Harbour Police at the gangway and stamped for landing, but passengers for England or the frontier as described by France must obtain Marseilles consular and prefectural visa.
