

EXECUTIVE COUNCIL.

No. 294.

Regulations made by the Governor in Council under Section 4 of the Merchant Shipping Amendment Ordinance, 1917, (Ordinance No. 13 of 1917), on the 28th day of June, 1917.

LANDING REGULATIONS.

1. No person or thing shall be landed from any steamship exceeding sixty tons except at the port of destination named on the clearance of such steamship.

2. Every person who does or is a party to any act forbidden by the foregoing regulation shall be liable to a fine not exceeding \$200 or to imprisonment for any term not exceeding six months.
