COLONIAL SECRETARY'S DEPARTMENT.

No. 409.—It is hereby notified that His Excellency the Officer Administering the Government has been pleased to exclude the Police Magistrates' Department from the operation of the Holidays Ordinance, 1912, Ordinance No. 5 of 1912, on Monday, the 25th November, 1918.

No. 410.—It is hereby notified that the Government Offices and Government Schools will be closed at 1 p.m. on Thursday, the 24th October, 1918.

No. 411.—It is hereby notified, with reference to Notifications No. 534 of the 10th December, 1915, and No. 227 of the 14th June, 1918, that members of His Majesty's Forces arriving in the United Kingdom from overseas are not required to register.
