DEFINITION OF BANKING BUSINESS.

"Banking Business" for the purposes of the said Ordinance means receiving money on current account or on deposit: accepting bills of exchange: making, discounting, buying, selling, collecting or dealing in bills of exchange, promissory notes and drafts whether negotiable or not: buying, selling or collecting coupons: buying or selling foreign exchange by cable-transfer or otherwise: issuing for subscription or purchase or underwriting the issue of loans, shares or securities: making or negotiating loans for commercial or industrial objects: or granting and issuing letters of credit and circular notes: except in so far as such operations form part of and are for the purposes of and incidental to the conduct of a business carried on for other purposes by the company, firm or indidual by whom such operations are transacted.
