No. 269.—It is hereby notified that on and after the 1st June, 1920, the use of the Hongkong Non-Local Storm Signal Code will be discontinued at Blackheads Hill and the China Seas Storm Signal Code substituted. The Local Signals will be removed from Blackheads Hill and hoisted on the Radio mast at the Royal Observatory.

The China Seas Code necessitates a masthead symbol which should not be mistaken for a black signal of the Local Code.
