

III. Paragraph 5 of clause 1 is amended by the insertion of the following proviso immediately after the words "six months of service" in the fifth line thereof:—

"Provided that this provision shall not apply to any officer who comes within the provisions of sub-paragraph (3) of paragraph 1 of this clause."

IV. Clause 18 is amended by the substitution of "\$300" for "\$240" in the fifth and sixteenth lines thereof.

V. The following clause is added immediately after clause 18:—

No. 18A.

Gratuity to widows of officers who have served fifteen years on the temporary establishment.

A gratuity at the rate of one month's salary in respect of each three years' service may be granted to the widow of any officer who has continuously served on the temporary establishment of the Colony and who at the date of his death was in receipt of a salary not exceeding \$300 per annum.

VI. References in this notification to particular "lines" of clauses or paragraphs shall be held to refer to the lines of such clauses and paragraphs as printed in the Regulations of Hongkong, 1914.
