No. 602.

*Regulations made by the General Officer Commanding the Troops, under section 11 of the Volunteer Ordinance, 1920, Ordinance No. 2 of 1920, on the 23rd day of October, 1924.*

Regulation 3 in the First Schedule to the Volunteer Ordinance, 1920, is hereby amended as follows:—

1. By the addition of the following words to paragraph (1):—

“(e) A reserve of officers.”

2. By the addition of the following paragraphs:—

“(13) Every officer of the Corps who shall be absent from the Colony for a longer period than fifteen consecutive months shall be transferred to the reserve of officers, notwithstanding that such absence or any part thereof may have been prior to the date of these regulations.

(14) An officer who shall have been transferred to the reserve of officers and shall thereafter return to the Colony may be transferred to the active list or retained in the reserve of officers at the discretion of the Administrative Commandant of the Corps.

(15) Members of the reserve of officers shall not be required to undergo any training or to attend at any inspection or parade but must report for duty when the Volunteer Corps is called out for actual military service in accordance with section 12 of the Volunteer Ordinance, 1920”.
