Rule made by the Governor in Council under section 36 of the Tramway Ordinance, 1902, Ordinance No. 10 of 1902, on the 5th day of January, 1927.

Appendix A to the rules made by the Governor in Council under section 36 of the Tramway Ordinance, 1902, which is set forth on page 290 of the Regulations of Hong Kong, 1844-1925, and which specifies the places at which cars shall be brought to a stand-still, is hereby amended by the deletion of the words "Junction of Des Vœux Road Central and Jubilee Street, at Central Market", in lines 14 and 15, and the substitution therefor of the words "Junction of Des Vœux Road Central and Queen Victoria Street". The foregoing rule shall come into operation on the 10th day of January, 1927.
