EXECUTIVE COUNCIL.

It is hereby notified that the Governor in Council has determined that on and after the 14th day of February, 1927, the Air Mail fees applicable to letters from Hong Kong for transmission by the United States Air Mail Service, regardless of distance or route, will be 36 cents for each ounce or fraction thereof. This fee is in addition to the regular postage.

The Merchant Shipping Ordinance, 1899, Ordinance No. 10 of 1899, Table L, Quarantine Regulations.

It is hereby proclaimed by order of His Excellency the Governor in Council that Vladivostock is a place at which an infectious or contagious disease prevails.

No. 74.—His Excellency the Governor in Council has been pleased to direct under section 7 of the Public Health and Buildings Ordinance, 1903, Ordinance No. 1 of 1903, that the name of Mr. Garnet Rankin be added to the List of Authorized Architects published in Government Notification No. 408 of the 10th July, 1925.
