Table M in the Schedule to the Merchant Shipping Ordinance, 1899, is hereby amended by the insertion, under the heading "(V)—Telegraph Cable Grounds", of the following regulation:—

18. A cable ground is established between the village of Aberdeen and the north east corner of Aberdeen Island within the following boundaries:—

Eastern boundary,—A line drawn from the north east corner of Aberdeen Island to the mainland, bearing 188° 14′, marked by two beacons in transit on Aberdeen Island.

Western boundary,—A line drawn from the north east corner of Aberdeen Island to the mainland, bearing 180° 25′, marked by two beacons in transit on Aberdeen Island.

Northern boundary,—The foreshore of Aberdeen Village. Southern boundary,—The foreshore of Aberdeen Island.
