Regulations made by the Governor in Council under section 3 of the Industrial Employment of Women, Young Persons and Children Ordinance, 1922, Ordinance No. 22 of 1922, on the 23rd day of June, 1930.

The regulations in the Schedule to the Industrial Employment of Women, Young Persons and Children Ordinance, 1922, amended as appears in Government Notifications Nos. 627 of 1929 and 245 of 1930, are hereby further amended as follows:—

- (1) Regulations 3 and 4 are rescinded and the following regulation is substituted therefor:—
 - 4. No person shall employ any child under the age of 12 years in any industrial undertaking.
- (2) Regulation 2A is renumbered "3".
- (3) Regulation 10A is amended by the substitution of "9 p.m. and 7 a.m." for "10 p.m. and 6 a.m."
