GENERAL POST OFFICE.

No. 427.—It is hereby notified for general information that the Postal Administrations of the Straits Settlements and Federated Malay States, have decided by virtue of the provision of the following Sections of Article 33 of the Convention of London, to prohibit the exchange of Clubbed Packages with Hong Kong as from 1st August, 1930, *viz.*:—

ARTICLE 33.

Section 4.—Letters must not contain any letter, note or document which has the character of actual and personal correspondence, addressed to persons other than the addressee or persons living with him.

Section 8.—Apart from the exceptions prescribed by the Convention and its Detailed Regulations, articles which do not fulfil the conditions laid down in the present Article and the corresponding Articles of the Detailed Regulations are not forwarded.
