No. 730.—His Excellency the Governor has been informed by the Secretary of State for the Colonies that notice has been given to the Italian Government of the desire of His Majesty's Government that the provisions of the Anglo-Italian Agreement (Cmd. 3385) for mutual recognition of passenger ship certificates and emigrant ship regulations should be extended to this Colony.

Reciprocal recognition accordingly will be accorded, and it has been intimated that the necessary instructions have been conveyed to the Maritime Authorities of Italian ports.
