The Governor in Council hereby declares that an occasion exists, in those districts of the Colony to which Part II of the Public Health and Buildings Ordinance, 1903, applies, which, for the prevention of cholera, necessitates the coming into force of By-laws Nos. 9 (b) and 9 (c) of the By-laws for the prevention and mitigation of epidemic, endemic, contagious infectious disease made under the above-mentioned. Ordinance.

Notice.

- 9 (b). No person shall sell or offer for sale any fresh fruit unless the same is whole, that is to say, uncut and unpeeled.
- 9 (c). No person shall sell or offer for sale ice-cream, or any frozen or chilled preparation commonly known as 'ice cream' unless the seller holds a permit in writing in that behalf signed by the Head of the Sanitary Department and by the Medical Officer of Health.
